

An Environmental Compliance Audit is undertaken to verify that a development is being established in line with the conditions within its Environmental Authorisation(s). An audit is performed in term of Section 34 of EIA of EIA Regulations, 2014 (as amended) and against an EA, Waste Management License or WULA.
